PASSENGER RAIL MAKES SENSE FOR OHIOANS

ON THE ROAD

- The total cost to own and operate a personal vehicle in Ohio is \$7-10k¹, while the median individual wage is less than \$44,500 annually²
- The average Ohioan wastes 20 gallons of gas and spends 49 hours every year sitting in traffic.³
- Ohio averages 1,200 traffic fatalities every year.⁴
- 1/5 of adults between the ages of 20 and 25 and 3/5 of those aged 16-19 do not have a driver's license.⁵
- 10% of American adults of all ages **never or** rarely drive.⁶

ON THE RAILS

- 20x safer per mile traveled than driving.
- Costs \$0.14 less per median mile than traveling by automobile.
- Allows for comfortable, productive travel with access to WiFi and safe cell phone usage.
- The proposed 3C&D corridor will serve at least 20 Fortune 500 companies and 150,000 college students.
- Improved transportation connectivity increases property values, business activity, and tourism traffic.¹⁰
